

SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The Board of Education is a seven member Board elected by district residents. Each member of the Board of Education shall serve for three years. The terms of office of Board of Education members shall not all expire in the same year. Board of Education members are responsible for school district management and policy-making.

The legal status of the Board of Education is that of a corporate body established pursuant to the laws of New York State. Any liability of the district is a liability of the Board of Education as a corporation and not that of the members of the Board of Education as individuals.
