

## **DEVELOPING BOARD POLICY**

The Board of Education recognizes that instructional and non-instructional staff play a most important role in the educational process. The Board of Education recognizes that all staff members are an important resource in developing policies for the District. The Board of Education further recognizes that students are participants in the education process and are affected by the policies adopted by the Board of Education .

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent of Schools and all members of the administration to establish procedures and/or lines of communication which will attempt to obtain input from instructional and non-instructional staff and students during the decision making process.

It is recognized that although the Board of Education considers input from the public, staff, and students, the ultimate responsibility of establishing policy rests with the Board of Education , and its determinations shall be final.
