Strategic Intent #5:

By 2024, 90% of respondents to the district Family Engagement survey will agree/strongly agree with the statement(s):

- Our school actively engages our family in conversations around needs/progress.
- During family conferences, teachers explain specific data about progress.
- Teachers contact me; not just in times of concern.
- Our school report cards provide families with clear information.

Strategy and Action Plans
Strategy #5.1: The District Comprehensive Communication Plan will articulate specific expectations for engaging families around the needs and progress of their children.
5.1a Establish and implement a back-to-school protocol for welcoming students and families in a way that sets a positive tone for the new school year.
5.1b Ensure that updated information regarding students' academics, behavior, and attendance is available to families at a minimum of every two weeks.
5.1c Include students and families in developing and communicating district grading systems, progress reports, and report cards.
5.1d Provide professional development and resources to support FCSD staff members in communicating with families in an effective, culturally responsive and developmentally appropriate manner.
5.1e Develop a common K-12 template for sharing course and grade-level curriculum, assessment, and learning expectations with families.
5.1f Establish a district-wide family engagement advisory board with representation from each building.
5.1g Hold student-led conferences a minimum of once a year to empower all K-12 students in sharing their academic, social, and behavioral needs, progress and goals.
