 - **Senior Picnic-** June 11th @ Green Lakes (Fayetteville)
 - Students must sign-up
 - **Senior Ball-** June 12th- Bayshore (Oswego), 6:00-10:00
 - Dinner will be inside
 - Dancing will be outside (pavilion available if it rains)
 - Need to remain with “pod” (similar to Prom)
 - **Graduation-** Drive-up (June 18), Traditional (June 19)- ceremony times will depend on how many sessions. Keeping the total number under 200 (may change...)
 - If there is a section for vaccinated people, could we have more people attend the ceremony?
- **ECHS- Update on both programs (Information Tech & Health Science)**
 - **Scope & Sequence**
 - Regular collaboration with CCC, Oswego Health, Oswego County Workforce Development Board is key.
 - Working on internships and shadowing experiences
 - Currently working with Junior High Staff to recruit for next year
 - Health Sciences Program includes students from Mexico and Hannibal
- **GRB Summer Institute**
 - Offering 1-week interest sessions for our students (includes incoming freshmen)
 - Sessions will run from July 6th-August 13th
 - Currently recruiting staff and then will start registering students
 - E-sports - will run the entire summer.
 - Breakfast, lunch and transportation will be provided.
 - No decision yet regarding academic summer school
 - We are offering many recovery options right now.

- **Follow-up to District Site Meeting (Stimulus funding and needs)**
 - Learning Loss
 - Time for teachers to work with students in a small group settings
 - Unique needs of students with unique challenges
 - “Help Lab” - Someone available every bell
 - Purchasing educational technology
 - Redesign the tech rooms
 - Redesign library - Collaborative learning spaces for students & adults
 - Mental health services and supports
 - Improve the way we use community agency support
 - Summer learning and supplemental after school programs
 - Reorienting students to the building
 - Mentoring students at all levels
 - Need to train student how to work with/mentor others
 - How do we sustain innovative programs?
