### Question- Has there been any talk about remote learning next year?

- There has been no discussion about remote learning for the 2021-22 school year. Our goal is 100% in-person learning.

- **GRB [Summer Institute](#)**
  - 50 Students participating in the Summer Institute
  - 50 Students participating in Esports
  - Academic summer programming:
    - ELA-21, Math- 22, Science- 11, SS- 13 (approximate #s)
      - These are students who can recover courses over the summer.
      - Students must receive a minimum of 20 hours of instruction to earn course credit.
    - Looking at elective area needs by individual students

*Question- Have we seen an increase in the Graduation Rate due to the Regents Exemptions?* Not last year because, for the most part, seniors had taken the required exams by their senior year. We expect to see an increase this year.

- 6% of this cohort has dropped out.
- *Comment made- Going forward, we have to keep in mind that students are going to have to take the Regents exams and this could sway the Graduation Rate. (We also need to remember that, before the Pandemic, the NYS Board of Regents was looking at Regents Exams in relation to Graduation Requirements.*

- **End-of-Year Survey**

- 66 parents, 67 students responded
  - Based on feedback throughout the year, we need to set consistent, high expectations as we enter the new school year.
  - Scholarship information needs to go to parents (as well as students). Parents checked Naviance but couldn't see scholarship opportunities.
  - Many students said they struggled, but also felt they were receiving adequate support.

- **Graduation 2022**

- Families want to keep the ceremony on the Athletic Complex (Site Team agrees).
- Discussed a Friday evening ceremony (6/17):
  - *Comment made- Events scheduled earlier than 7:00pm are hard for parents who work full time. (Would need to begin the ceremony at 6:00 in order to have daylight for photos when it ends (7:30).*
  - It's Father's Day weekend, will that be an issue?
    - *No, parents expect there to be events in June (awards ceremonies, concerts, etc.).*
- Discussed set-up:
  - *Need to think about accessibility issues with the bleachers. Guests may struggle up there.*
  - *Students with accessibility issues need to be at the bottom of the bleachers.*
  - *Guests may have liked to have had a better view of the speakers.*



- **Graduation Parade**

- Families really like the Graduation Parade, particularly how it starts at the JH and ends at GRB.
- Teachers said that they didn't attend due to seeing the graduates at the Graduation Walk at their schools the prior day.
- Need more community advertisement next year.
- Should we enter the Graduation Parade in the Memorial Day parade?
  - *That is a lot of responsibility.*
  - *It would be tough to control all the cars.*
  - *Would not recommend it.*
- *Put an ad in the Valley news, and other local media, encouraging community members to attend.*
- *Have clubs set up tables celebrating their senior members.*

- Students want to see their old classrooms.
  - Elementary - go inside
  - JH - stay outside
